**Papal Visit:** We have just received notification of our passes for the Papal Visit. The Beatification Mass in Birmingham on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2010, we have been allocated 7 passes. The cost is £30 which includes coach travel and a Pilgrim Pack. The Hyde Park Prayer Vigil on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2010, we have been allocated 9 passes.
