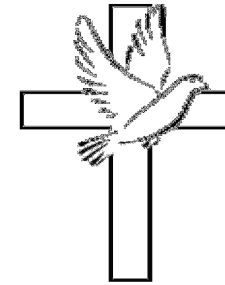

Entrance Antiphon:
